

Notes from Meeting in Offices of Wexford Co Council

Held on the 7th of June 2022.

Location: First Floor. Time 2.15pm to 3.15pm.

Present: Elizabeth Hore, Director of Services, Anita McLoughlin, FOI Official, Seamus Power, Martin Power.

CC. Elizabeth Hore, Anita McLoughlin, Anthony Bailey, Tom Enright David Minogue.

1. The meeting scheduled for the 7th of June 2022 commenced at 2.15pm in the Council offices at Carriglawn.
2. Elizabeth Hore (EH) confirmed that she had not spoken to Tom Enright since the meeting of 31st May 2022 and had not completed reading the report that MP submitted to David Minogue on 2nd Feb 2022.
3. Seamus Power (SP) said he was disappointed that EH had not completed reading the Report and had not spoken to Tom Enright
4. SP said that he predicted at the last meeting that there would be more delays and that the EH delay was more of the same.
5. EH confirmed she was going on annual leave for four weeks on Tues 14th June 2022 and MP asked who would be dealing with the matter in her absence and EH said nobody, as she wanted to deal with this matter herself.
6. SP said this was totally unacceptable given the time that had passed since MP first met Tom Enright and David Minogue on 20th January 2022.

7. EH said she had only taken over the case since 5th May 2022 but understood the frustration of MP and SP.
8. MP said it was totally unacceptable that [REDACTED] allowed [REDACTED] to retire without addressing the issues raised in the Report he submitted to David Minogue on 2nd February 2022.
9. SP said that the departure of [REDACTED] without him contesting MPs Report of 2nd February 2022 must be seen as an acceptance by the Council that the content of MPs Report is correct and accurate.
10. MP asked EH had she got copies of minutes from the meeting with Tom Enright and David Minogue on 20th January last and from the meeting of 2nd February last with David Minogue and Emer Kennedy.
11. Anita McLoughlin (AM) said there was no minutes available for these meetings.
12. SP said this was totally unacceptable and said it appears that EH was starting from scratch as if nothing had happened previously in relation to the Anne Street investigation and asked is it the policy of the Council to keep no records about this matter.
13. AM agreed to look again to see what notes or minutes could be found.
