Dail Question No: 333

To ask the Minister for Transport if Iarnród Éireann will clarify their understanding of the planning permission which is in place for the new railway bridge over the Dublin Rosslare railway line at Park/Carcur Wexford (details supplied); and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Details Supplied: The bridge referred to is “ The new overbridge will be located at 91 miles, 1688 yards on the Dublin to Rosslare railway line. The overbridge will connect to the existing approach road which has been constructed from the R730 / Stoney Park roundabout up to the entrance to Faythe Harriers GAA Club.”

Answer

As Minister of Transport, I have responsibility for policy and overall funding of public transport. The operation, maintenance and renewal of the rail network, including any proposed works at the referenced location on the Rosslare line, is a matter for Iarnród Éireann (IÉ) in the first instance.
